- Are you 16 years old or older?
- Did you check the traffic rules?
- Did you learn how to drive?



If you repeatedly commit dangerous acts(17 items) on a small motorized vehicle, you will be ordered to take a "specified small motorized vehicle driver's training"!



# ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN IN THE EVENT OF A TRAFFIC ACCIDENT

If you are involved in a traffic accident (or if you cause an accident), you must immediately

### ①Stop riding

②Rescue the injured and dial 119 if any③Move your vehicle to a safe location④Call the police (dial 110)

#### Only sidewalk with road signs



Only sidewalk with road signs, etc., that say "FOR REGULAR BICYCLES and PEDESTRIANS ONLY" may be used for passage.

Drive closer to the roadway than the center of the sidewalk Special specified small motorized vehicles must pass on the sidewalk in the area for regular bicycles



\*When you ride the vehicles on sidewalks,

note that pedestrians have priority!

#### SPECIAL SPECIFIED SMALL MOTORIZED VEHICLE

A special specified small motorized vehicle is a specified small motorized bicycle that meets all of the following criteria and is not towing another vehicle.

#### < REQUIREMENTS >

- The maximum speed indicator light must be flashing while the vehicle is passing on a sidewalk, etc.
- The vehicle must be structurally incapable of reaching a speed in excess of 6 kilometers per hour.
- $\,\bigcirc\,$  The vehicle must not be equipped with side wheels.
- $\, \bigcirc \,$  The brake must be in a position to be easily operated while the vehicle is in motion.
- $\,\bigcirc\,$  No sharp protruding parts that could harm pedestrians.
